

Energy Tax Credits

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 gives significant energy efficiency tax credits for home improvements in 2009 - 2010. Tax credit applies to material only. Up to \$1,500 total tax credit on material only in 2009 - 2010.

NOTE: ENERGY STAR labeled windows/doors and skylights installed January - May 2009 qualify for tax credit. Installed after June 1, 2009 must meet the specifications below.
